Back Story:

The Star of David project was spearheaded by congregants Alice and Tom Holloway for their daughter Rachel's Bat Mitzvah on May 5, 2001. Created and co-funded with Nancy and Bryan Grover, it was the debut of the sanctuary set-up that continues today. It includes the Eternal Light hung from the projection screen, moving the piano, and the installation of a wireless microphone on the Bimah. In another first, Rabbi Stevens, offered passages from the yet-to-be-released prayer book we currently use. There were three B'Not Mitzvahs in three consecutive months that year: Rachel Holloway, Allison Brzezinski, and Daniel Infeld.
